This workshop will be an overview of some of the concepts and strategies taught in the Crisis Prevention Institute's Nonviolent Crisis Intervention program. This model is used by district staff to understand the signs of any level of a crisis, from a situation verbal escalation to something more significant. How we identify and know how to respond to escalations can allow adults to maintain our relationship with the young people in our care, which is what we all want for our children. The skills and concepts covered as part of Sharing Strategies can aid in the continuity of a young person's overall development and having parents and other caregivers understand these approaches allows each adult to be able to use some of the approaches in other settings, such as a young person's home. Caregivers can also be able to provide staff members with additional information about a young person's behavior, i.e. the ways the young person shows anxiety and the approaches that may help when the young person experiences upset. We look forward to collaborating with parents through sharing these strategies.
