Dear Parents and Guardians,

In this last week of the first semester, students are preparing to take mid-term examinations. The results of these assessments provide information about your child's achievement in each class, help teachers plan for the remainder of the course, and are calculated into your child's overall grade.

- Mid-term exams begin on Tuesday, January 17th and conclude on Friday, January 20th.
- The first exam for each day begins each morning at 7:30 and ends at 9:30. The second exam for each day begins at 9:50 and ends at 11:50.
- Students are not allowed to leave campus between exams, however, they may arrive late or leave early if they have prearranged transportation.
- Students who choose to come to school to study during an open period must report to the cafeteria for the entire period.
- **All students will be dismissed at the end of the second exam at 11:55 on Tuesday – Friday. Transportation will be provided at this time for both in-district and out-of-district students.**
- **Monday, January 23rd, is a modified school day and the last day of the first semester. Students will report to all of their classes following a modified day schedule where teachers will provide a brief exam review.** (Students who missed a specific exam will be directed to another location during the exam's review time.)
- **Students will be dismissed at 11:55 each day. At this dismissal, all out-of-district, Woodbury, and Bethlehem busses will arrive for student pick up.**
- Region 14 busses will be available for Region 14 students at 2:15 for those students taking a make-up exam from 12:30 – 2:15.
- **The cafeteria will be open each day for breakfast and snacks from 7:00 – 10:15.**
- If your child is ill and will miss an exam, please notify the school prior to the end of the missed exam period. Upon his/her return to school, the student must discuss exam make-up options with the teacher(s) which may take place at an agreed upon time prior to January 27th. Students may also make up exams during the scheduled make-up sessions on January 20th and 23rd.

If there is a delayed opening because of weather on an exam day, the regularly scheduled exams will occur as follows:

First scheduled exam: 9:30 – 11:30

Cafeteria open 8:00 – 12:30 with lunch served from 11:00 – 12:30

Second scheduled exam: 12:10 – 2:10

All busses will pick up students at 2:15 on a delayed opening.
