The Educational Specifications for the Proposed Building Project at NHS & MES

Any changes should be highlighted and then sent to the Facilities Committee for review with Mike Molson and Jim Reese. Once that is complete the plans for all four schools will come before the BOE for discussion and approval.

Position of Assistant Superintendent of Curriculum

J. Goeler spoke of the importance of this position in moving Reg. 14 forward. Due to unexpected additional costs incurred by deconfiguration the funds that were suppose to be budgeted for this position are not available in the 2011-2012 budget. The Superintendent will present this position along with other requests for the 2012-2013 budget for the BOE to review.

M. Van Aken spoke of the need for a Resource Officer for Reg. 14. She would like to convene a "Safety Summit" and invite Selectmen, Law Enforcement and Community Members from both towns to discuss this position.
