The meeting was called to order by M. Van Aken at 5:35pm.

The committee discussed the following:

1. Presentation by Nate Levinson, Special Education Consultant:

Mr. Levinson gave the Comm. an overview of the services provided by The District Management Council. The Opportunities Review encompasses General Education Staff and practices as well as Special Education Staff and practices. The goals of the Review are:

1. Raising Student Achievement

2. Controlling Costs, typically a district our size could see a savings of \$1,000,000-\$3,000,000.

3. Improving Parent Satisfaction.

The entire process usually takes between 4-6 months at a cost of \$125,000. This cost includes membership to all DMC Services as well as an Action Plan and Planning Retreat.

P. Zmek suggested we contact Futures Education, another Spec. Ed. consultant group she spoke with at the CABE Convention and have them present to the Planning Comm. so that we could compare both groups before recommending one to the BOE. J. Goeler said he would contact them and set up a date for their presentation.
