Good Afternoon,

As you all know from Dr. Olzacki's letter sent home on Wednesday, students at Woodbury Middle School will be returning to in-person learning beginning Tuesday, January 19. Students will attend classes in person on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. Please note that Wednesdays will continue to be a remote learning day with asynchronous learning and teacher support time for students. The daily schedule with detailed times may be found [here](#).

We will continually monitor all safety protocols to ensure student and staff safety. For students who are full-time remote learners, classes may no longer be live-streamed for the full class period. There may be a 5 to 10-minute live introduction by the teacher, and then students will be asked to visit the google classroom to complete assigned work. Full-time remote learners are asked to utilize the google classroom help desk on their teacher's page to ask questions about assignments or support. Teachers will also be available to assist full-time remote learners during the 7:15-8:15 am time slot and Wednesdays.

Those who opt **NOT** to have their student(s) return to in-person learning should complete the [Remote Learning Request Survey](#) (linked here) **even if you have provided previous notification**. This survey should be completed by Monday, January 11, 2021, for each of your students in the district.

Students returning to full time learning from remote learning will need to complete the [Region 14 Request to Return Form](#) before returning to school.

A few reminders for our returning students:

- Lockers were assigned before full-time distance learning. Students may use lockers for coats only and will be able to access them at the start and end of the school day
- Phones should be off and secured in backpacks
- **FREE breakfasts and FREE lunches**, paid for through monies provided by the U.S. government, are available in all our schools every day
- Mask breaks will be given and scheduled through grade-level teams
