 - Review and discussion of current and projected enrollment figures for both Mitchell Elementary School and Bethlehem Primary School;
 - Review and discussion of current and projected staffing needs for both K/2 and 3/5 model versus K-5 model:
 - Review and discussion of facilities and classrooms available for BES and MES;
 - Review of historical boundary line and extended boundary line for K-5 model;
 - Review and discussion of class size guidelines under current configuration and K/5 model.

The following agenda item unrelated to reconfiguration was addressed:

- 2. Discussion regarding safe roads for current R14 bus routes
 - Review and discussion of current bus route requirements
 - Review and discussion of safety issues stemming from travel on unpaved roads
