Mrs. Hutchins reported on her behalf to share news of DESSA and Aperture; new tools that will be used to monitor and assess each student's social and emotional skill set. Each teacher will do a brief assessment for each child to determine whether students require additional support for social and emotional learning. This will allow for targeted intervention for students.

 - Tori mentioned that we are partnering with Ist Day School supplies. We would like to gather grade level supply lists by mid March to make sure families can order supplies at their convenience. This is not a fundraiser.

- Available funds of roughly \$10,100 less outstanding checks. That number will shrink as we pay for assemblies and fifth grade activities.
- Tori reported that we had planned for the budget in May knowing that we had a number of initiatives and projects we hoped to fund. Our expenses have been higher than expected while our income is significantly below what we expected. We are projecting that we'll be at 60% of anticipated income.
