
REGISTRATION DATES: AUGUST 17, 2022 - OCTOBER 1, 2022

- UConn Early College Experience Students register online for their courses using the
 UConn ECE registration system at <u>UConn.DualEnroll.com</u>.
- All Student registration requests once submitted must be approved by the high school
 Site Representative, approved by a parent/guardian, and payment information collected
 (if applicable) to be processed. The registration process MUST happen in that order.

- Regardless of your student status (new or returning UConn ECE Student) you are required to complete the UConn.DualEnroll.com registration process as it is new this year.

REGISTRATION STEPS:

To register for UConn courses taught at your high school through the UConn Early College Experience Program you must complete the following steps:

- Go to https://uconn.dualenroll.com/ to create a personalized login. As the Student, be sure to provide your PERSONAL e-mail address and cell phone number so that we can confirm your account. Save your login and password for future use.
- Complete the application. Double check the application form to ensure
 the accuracy of all the information you have provided. Be prepared with
 your Social Security Number, parent/guardian contact information, and
 UConn course list.

- 3. Select your course(s). On the course selection screen, use the navigation tools to see the course options that are available through your high school. Pay careful attention to the course titles and instructor names to make sure you are selecting the appropriate course(s).
- 4. Confirm your course selection(s). You, as the Student, are done!
