Soliciting Funds from and by Students

School personnel shall be encouraged to educate students about services performed by humanitarian agencies. However, fundraising shall not be conducted by non-school agencies or for non-school activities among students except as provided by law and approved by the Regional School District No. 14 Board of Education.

Fundraising for School Activities

While the Regional School District No. 14 Board of Education recognizes the fact that fundraising will take place to support extracurricular school activities, every effort should be made by each Principal to keep the solicitations to a reasonable number within each school. Only one major fund raising activity should be held at a time.

When students are involved in solicitations, they should be provided with appropriate identification, explaining the purpose of their fundraising, and carry out these activities in the company of another student or adult.

Elementary children shall not be requested to solicit funds for school or class activities door to door. Middle school children are required to be accompanied by an adult when soliciting funds for school or class activities.
