

Community Relations

Solicitation of Funds/Promotional Literature

The Board of Education recognizes the value of the personal development of our students through their participation in charitable and humanitarian efforts.

Guidelines for such actions are:

1. They shall not benefit any profit-making organization.
2. Funds shall not be solicited from or by school personnel.
3. Promotional literature, including fliers, pamphlets and posters, which are of a non-fundraising or fee basis character, and which are sponsored by either a school or non-school organization may be distributed subject to approval by the Superintendent.
4. Direct fundraising activities by non-school agencies or representatives in the schools or at school functions is prohibited.
5. There will be one charitable/humanitarian fundraiser allowed per school annually. Additional fundraising activities must be approved by the Superintendent of Schools.
6. The building Principal shall submit to the Superintendent for approval, the name of any organization for which fundraising by students is planned.
