PARENT-TEACHER COMMUNICATION

In order to encourage parent-teacher communication, the Superintendent of Schools is authorized to develop and implement written procedures to encourage parent-teacher communication. These procedures may include school newsletters, required regular contact with all parents, flexible parent-teacher conferences, drop-in hours for parents, home visits and the use of technology such as student/parent database communication systems, email, or homework hotlines to allow parents to check on their children's assignments and students to get assistance if needed.
