Parents/Guardians/Staff:

Nonnewaug High School is in the process of having renovation, demolition and abatement activities performed throughout the building. The work started in 2017 and will continue throughout 2020. The upcoming abatement/remediation phases of the project involving asbestos and PCB containing materials are planned to occur February 6 through June 20, 2019. The building materials requiring abatement/remediation include interior flooring materials, pipe and pipe fitting insulation, wall adhesives and contaminated wall materials, sink undercoating, wall/ceiling/column paint, sheetrock taping compound, textured ceiling paint, ceramic floor tile damp-proofing, science countertops/adhesives/caulking compounds, science lab hoods and test tube racks, cove base adhesives, window sealant compounds and associated damp-proofing materials and limited attic roofing materials.

The Connecticut Department of Public Health (CT DPH) is involved with this project since abatement will occur during school session. Abatement is scheduled to be performed 2nd shift between 3:00 p.m. – 11:00 p.m. Monday to Friday, Saturdays 6:30 a.m. to 11:00 p.m. (if needed) and Sundays as needed, February 6 through June 20, 2019. Vacations/Holidays/Closures are scheduled for February 15 and 18, April 15 to 19, and May 27. Work will be between the hours of 6:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. on these days. Langan CT has performed the abatement/remediation design for this project and is working closely with CT DPH to ensure that the work will be performed properly. CT DPH will be reviewing and approving this portion of the project.

The intent of this letter is to inform you that asbestos/PCB removal will be performed February through June 2019 and will occur in regulated areas using appropriate engineering controls. The Connecticut licensed asbestos company AAIS will perform the abatement/ remediation work. Langan CT, an independent environmental consultant (or its representative), will monitor the project. The monitoring includes, but is not limited to, daily inspections, air sampling during abatement activities and final post abatement visual inspections and re-occupancy air sampling.

As required by CT DPH, this notification is being sent to all parents and guardians of the children/students, faculty, and staff associated with Nonnewaug High School.
