REMINDER

Bethlehem Elementary School will be conducting a K – 5 Science Fair on Wednesday January 23, 2019 from 6:00 pm to 7:00 pm. Projects will be displayed in the school gym. Certificates and ribbons will be given to every student entering a project in the fair. The projects will NOT be judged against each other for prizes or places. Our goal is to develop a love of science! (Please no projects that require an open flame or live animals)

Projects should be brought to school on Tuesday January 22, 2019 from 3:00PM – 5:00pm. We will be there to assist in the set up and display of projects. The projects will be on display all day Wednesday for classes to visit before the fair that evening. All projects must be taken home at the conclusion of the science fair Wednesday evening.

We hope that your student would love to participate but please remember this is optional and is to be fun. We really want them to love science.

The following guidelines have been established for entries in the Science Fair:

1. Participation is OPTIONAL.
2. Children should complete projects with MINIMAL adult assistance. (The assistance should be in the form of advice, gathering information and materials, and supervising any task that may be considered hazardous.)
3. All science projects should include three parts:
 - A. HYPOTHESIS: What it is you are trying to prove or to demonstrate
 - B. PROCEDURE: What steps did you follow? What materials did you use? Who helped you?
 - C. CONCLUSION: What did you learn from this experiment/project?

4. No more than \$15.00 should be spent providing materials for the project.
5. Science projects that require electricity MUST contain their own power supply. (batteries, solar power)
6. Please remember that space for displays is limited. Poster boards and science fair boards are allowed.
7. All participants will be asked to stand by their display for the first 15 min. of the science fair in order to answer any questions or to demonstrate their experiment. After 15 min., the participants are free to walk around the science fair and to view the rest of the projects.

The attached form is REQUIRED and is to be completed by the CHILD. Please bring the completed form with the project on Tuesday, January 23, 2019, when you set up for the Science Fair. Additional forms may be obtained from the office. We are looking forward to this exciting evening! Have fun and learn a lot while working on your project. Contact us if you have any questions.

Please return the bottom portion of this form to indicate if you are interested in participating. This does not commit you nor eliminate you from the science fair, it just helps us ensure that we have enough ribbons and certificates.
