

Minutes of the Planning Committee of the Board of Education

A meeting of the Planning Committee of the Regional School District 14 Board of Education was held on December 8, 2008 at 4:30 p.m. in the Conference Room of the Central Office, 5 Minortown Road, Woodbury, Connecticut.

Present were Dr. Robert Cronin, Nonnewaug Interim Principal Kim Gallo and committee members Linda Bulvanoski, Chuck Cosgriff, Monica Gati and Steve Sordi.

Linda Bulvanoski called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

The committee discussed the following items.

1. Music Department Offerings at Nonnewaug High School and how those electives are weighted.
2. The Planning Committee voted to have an early dismissal on December 23, 2008 as is common practice in many other school districts.
3. The Planning Committee approved a Vo-Ag out of state, overnight field trip to Lancaster, PA scheduled for January 9-10, 2009.
4. The Planning Committee decided to post information about Reading Enrichment Programs offered by the University College at Fairfield University on Parent Information Boards in each school
5. Dr. Cronin suggested the idea of featuring a presentation made by each school at future planning committee meetings. The Planning Committee concurred. Bethlehem Elementary School will be the first school to present.
6. Mrs. Gallo presented the changes that would appear in the Program of Studies at Nonnewaug High School for the 2009-2010 school year. Dr. Cronin asked to be provided with a copy of the curriculum for the new courses being proposed.
7. The Planning Committee discussed characteristics that they were looking for in a High School Principal.
8. Dr. Cronin presented a draft of his Organizational Chart. He wanted committee members to establish a common understanding of the new positions being proposed and their purpose.

Mrs. Gati made a motion to adjourn, seconded by Mr. Sordi. The Planning Committee Meeting was adjourned at 5:50 p.m.
